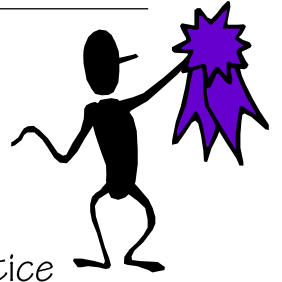


## Home Arts
